#### MEA's Mission

Our mission at MEA is to promote clean, affordable, reliable energy and energy-related greenhouse gas emission reductions to benefit Marylanders in a just and equitable manner.



### Solar Energy Equity Grant Program



Supports the design and installation of solar energy systems for low-to-moderate income, or in overburdened or underserved communities.

Each home must have received an energy audit and weatherization-type energy efficiency upgrades funded through MEA's Energy Equity Grant Program.

The Program will fund up to 100% of the solar photovoltaic (PV) system design and installation cost, up to \$25,000 per home.

#### **Energy Efficiency Equity Grant Program**

Grants are awarded for energy efficiency projects that generate significant reductions in energy use and pass on the benefits of the savings to Maryland's LMI residents.

\$19.5 million total program budget anticipated for FY24, to be allocated regionally across Maryland.



# Maryland Smart Energy Communities Grant Programs

The Maryland Smart Energy Communities (MSEC) programs are designed to support local governments, non-profits, schools, and communities as they adopt solutions to reduce energy usage and GHG emissions.

4 different AOIs: Clean Energy and Community

Development: MEA anticipates awarding a total of up to \$6,000,000 for energy efficiency projects, and \$4,000,000 for clean energy (including renewable energy) projects and transportation projects.



## Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) Equity Rebate Program

The Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) Rebate Program provides funding assistance for costs incurred acquiring and/or installing qualified EV supply equipment, also referred to as charging stations.



Up to 85% of the project costs.
